President & CEO's Message

After a year delay due to the pandemic, and nearly two years we'd like to forget but will always remember, we are in the final countdown to the 21st World Maccabiah Games. Following summer and fall tryouts, Maccabi USA's delegation is almost complete, with over 900 athletes appointed to date. Our previous record of over 1,100 in both 2013 and 2017 will be surpassed this July as we expect to send a delegation of 1,200+ strong.

As is always the case as we approach the Maccabiah, it has been "all hands on deck" for our professional team and lay leaders. General Chair Lou Moyerman, Vice-Chairs Tonja Magerman and Debbie Adams, Team Managers Leon Lifschutz and Matthew Halpern, and the Organizing Committee of over 100 have worked diligently to prepare for this enormous project.

New for this Maccabiah, we are excited to launch the Maccabi Media Program after a successful pilot at the 2019 European Maccabi Games. We will be selecting 14 aspiring sports media professionals who will be embedded within our delegation and will cover the Games like we've never covered them before. For anyone back in the US who can't make it to Israel to experience the Maccabiah firsthand, the Maccabi Media Program will bring the sights, sounds, and stories straight to you, via game streaming, athlete features, social media content, and more. For those friends, family, and fans who do make the trip next July, for the first time we will have three different options within our mission to meet your budgetary needs.

For our athletes, while Maccabi USA can't control the cost to attend the Maccabiah, we can control the ability to award scholarships. Both the need-based scholarship committee, chaired by Debbie, and merit-based scholarship committee, chaired by Tonja, have been hard at work and have already made significant awards to some of our athletes. Thank you to our other committee members as well for helping with these difficult and important decisions: Merit: Fred Cohen, Leon Lifschutz, Dave Rudzinsky, Lou Moyerman (General Chair), and Steve Graber (professional)

Need: Matthew Halpern, Walter Klores, Susan Morgan, Howard Solomon, Lou Moyerman (General Chair), and Steve Graber (professional)

At a retreat last year, the Interim Executive Committee determined that the #1 philanthropic goal of the organization was to endow the needbased scholarship fund in perpetuity. While we awarded over \$1M in 2017 and hope to do the same for these Games, we must dispel any sense that the Maccabiah is only for the rich, and to do that we must always make scholarship assistance available.

Determining the #1 priority was the easy part. Raising the funds to endow our need-based scholarship fund would be the hard part.

Then, like manna from heaven, our passionate alumnus and donor, Stuart Weitzman, offered to give \$5M to this need-based scholarship fund with the proviso that Maccabi USA raise another \$3M. Our leadership quickly donated \$500K, unlocking the first \$2M of this true matching gift and officially launching the Stuart Weitzman Scholarship Fund for athletes in financial need.

As we go public with this incredible show of generosity by Stuart, we are hopeful we'll raise the remaining \$2M+ so as not to leave any matching funds on the table. To that end, we respectfully ask that every member of the Maccabi USA family and community open your hearts and wallets to join Stuart and help us succeed in realizing the most transformative gift in the organization's 73-year history.

While Maccabi USA athletes compete for gold medals in Israel next summer, the American delegation is unveiling a new team that also expects to shine – although this group will be the one providing the spotlight. The inaugural Maccabi Media Program will debut at the 21st Maccabiah and feature 14 highly skilled students and aspiring sports media professionals. These young professionals will perform various broadcasting and video production roles and play a pivotal role in enhancing coverage of the Maccabiah back home. Chaired by Marc Zumoff, the recently retired voice of the Philadelphia 76ers, this program will offer first-rate mentorship to young reporters from top journalists in the field.



The Maccabi Media team is open to high school seniors, college students, and recent college graduates under age 25 who demonstrate strong video production skills and have chosen a career path in sports media. The recruitment phase will run through the end of 2021, with candidates applying from some of the country's top communications and journalism programs.

Letter from the Development Chair

Thanks to the incredible generosity of the Maccabi USA family, this has been a transformational year. We have already raised more money in 2021 than in any previous year, including the two largest gifts in the history of our organization: A \$5M matching gift opportunity from the Weitzman Family Foundation and \$1.65M from the RootOne initiative, both of which will help our athletes afford the cost of participation.

I was so impressed by how much the small professional team in Philadelphia was able to accomplish during this COVID pandemic. Their flexibility and thoughtfulness brought us new initiatives, like Maccabi USA @ Home and the forthcoming Maccabi Media Program, as well as new partnerships with organizations around the Jewish world, including the Jewish National Fund USA Boruchin Center, The iCenter, RootOne, and Momentum.

Much like they did with programming, the team doubled down on the fundraising side, writing more grants than ever before, creating new fundraising systems, implementing trainings for our chairs and coaches, reaching out to past, present, and future donors, and coordinating efforts with our endowment partners.

But most impressive of all was how the Maccabi USA family rallied so quickly behind the incredible Weitzman Family Foundation Challenge Match. In just six weeks, our leadership raised \$500K to unlock the first \$2M of the family's \$5M match. Fundraising for our annual



budget is one thing (and we are on track to reach our goals), but creating the newly endowed Stuart Weitzman Scholarship Fund for athletes in financial need is the opportunity of a lifetime. Your support will help us achieve both!

The speed, enthusiasm, and generosity of our donors shows the power of the Maccabi Movement and its impact on Jewish athletes, their families, the communities they live in, and the greater Jewish world. It is not an exaggeration to say that the people who have already given, and those of you who will give to this campaign, are truly changing lives and contributing to a more robust, diverse, and united global Jewish community.
