Once again, Maccabi USA's tremendous organizing skills and dedicated efforts produced a terrific American Delegation whose on-the-field achievements and off-the-field enthusiasm formed solid bases for all aspects and events of the 21st Maccabiah in Israel.

Maccabi USA 2022 - The World Record!

- ★ Numbering over 1,400 athletes and officials, the USA Delegation to Maccabiah 2022 enters the record-books not only as *the largest visiting delegation* in the history of Jewish Sports, but *in the entire history of international sports!*
- ★ At the 21st Maccabiah, for the first time in history since the first Maccabiah took place in 1932, we had the privilege of hosting the President of the United States Mr. Joe Biden. The excitement of the members of the delegation who met him, as well as those who had the privilege of walking in the opening ceremony, with the U.S. President watching them, was unique and moved those who watched the ceremony, locally and international.
- ★ Maccabi USA's athletic quality and depth was superb. Between the Juniors, Open, Masters and the Paralympic Athletes, Maccabi USA won 312 medals (2nd after Israel's Delegation). Israeli media and sports scouts were drawn to sports venues wherever young Americans competed, and when Chelsey Goldberg attended the press conference on the first day of Maccabiah, her inspiring personality, her personal achievements and her character moved everyone in the room.
- ★ Most important, primed by the outstanding MUSA Training Camp and Israel Connect program (Pre-camp), Maccabi USA embraced the great opportunity you gave them to discover and enjoy modern Israel for many, the Maccabiah was their first-ever visit to the Jewish State, their first encounter with Israelis and the global fellowship of Jewish athletes from 60 countries. Many of your athletes, and indeed, your coaches, experienced the Maccabiah as a personally significant Jewish and Zionist cultural and educational event in their lives.

American athletes and supporters brought enthusiasm and inspiration to everyone in the Maccabiah, and Maccabi USA repeated a 100% record for deportment, behavior and sportsmanship. That is one more grand tribute to MUSA's matchless recruiting, training, organizing, and total commitment to the ideals of Maccabi.

Having served as USA General Chair for both the 2013 and 2017 Maccabiot, I was so proud that Maccabi USA brought delegations of just over 1,100 each time, which were the largest delegations ever to travel to a multisport event.

In our wildest dreams, we never would have imagined that the 2022 delegation would total 1,351, a whopping increase of 21%!

Mazal tov and thank you to General Chair Lou Moyerman, Vice-Chairs Tonja Magerman and Debbie Adams, their entire organizing committee, and the outstanding professional team for this monumental success.

I have said that Maccabi USA's success is not determined by how many medals we bring back home, but rather by how many Jewish athletes we

bring over to Israel. While that is what I truly believe, it is in the context that our goal will always be to find the best athletes and win as many medals as possible.

The Maccabiah, after all, is the Jewish Olympics.

And, at the 21st Maccabiah, Team Maccabi USA won 305 medals! We won 103 gold, 105 silver, and 97 bronze. Of the 305 medals, Juniors won 101, Open 133, and Masters 71.

While Maccabi USA can't control the cost to go to the Maccabiah, we can control how much we award to need-based and merit-based athletes. I am proud to say that Maccabi USA awarded need-based scholarships totaling \$448K to 144 athletes, an average award of about \$3,100. In addition, we awarded merit-based scholarships totaling \$232K. to 69 athletes, an average award of \$3,360. On average, the \$680K awarded to 213 athletes reduced their cost by 38%.

In addition to these awards, Maccabi USA received a grant from Root One for all high school athletes. 371 Junior athletes received a grant of \$3K, which totaled \$1,113,000, a reduction of 35%.

So, the grand total of grants and awards for members for Team Maccabi USA was an amazing \$1,793,000!

Speaking of need-based scholarships and medals, our Maccabi USA angel and three-time athlete Stuart Weitzman won a bronze in the table tennis team competition. Thanks to Stuart's remarkable generosity, the need-based scholarship fund will be endowed in perpetuity, which will enable about 300 athletes to receive awards for every future Maccabiah.

Thank you, and God bless you, Stuart!

In my four decades of involvement with Maccabi USA, the biggest step forward was when we changed from a one-dimensional athletic event to a multi-dimensional program which included a cultural and educational component,

This took place in 1985, when we instituted the first "Pre-Camp," when the entire team gathered at Rutgers University for two days. By 1989, Pre-Camp morphed into a four-day experience in Israel. Eventually, Pre-Camp grew to six days and was renamed Israel Connect.

Thanks to generous grants from the Singer Foundation and Seed the Dream, for the first time we were able to add 40 educators to our program.

Israel Connect is the jewel of our Maccabiah program, and among the highlights include trips to Masada and the Dead Sea, as well as the Kotel. The grand finale of Israel Connect is the experiencing Yad Vashem. It is the ultimate reality check, as it puts into perspective the existence and importance of the Maccabiah. In a world where Anti-Semitism has exploded, even in the United States, nothing can be more important than exposing our delegation to the horrors of the Holocaust. And the visceral reaction can only be achieved by seeing it with their own eyes at Yad Vashem and luckily this year, also hearing firsthand from Holocaust survivors during our Lev L'Lev day.

Thanks to IC Chair Deb Lichtenfeld and Dan Kurtz for their dedication to making the program a great success.

We also had very successful Gold, Silver, and Bronze Missions, with a total of 261 participants. Thanks to the mother-daughter dynamic duo of Co-Chairs Debbie Adams and Stacey Klimchuk, with help from Development Chair Deb Lichtenfeld and our partners at Gil Travel.

An exciting new initiative was the inaugural Maccabi Media program, led by Marc Zumoff and Neal Slotkin.

The philosophy of the Movement under the leadership of Maccabi World Union Chairman Amir Peled is that "bigger is better." While the objective remains to have a high-quality athletic competition, the overarching goal is to bring as many Jewish athletes as possible to the Maccabiah and the State of Israel.

As the biggest Territorial Organization in the Diaspora, Maccabi USA has fully supported that mantra. Our Mission is more important than ever with the generation of Holocaust survivors, like my late mother Alice, rapidly dwindling, combined with the perverse rise in Anti-Semitism.

In order to accomplish that goal, a significant change in philosophy took place for the 21st Maccabiah. For the first time, the Movement decided to allow mixed/composite teams, combining athletes from more than one country. By doing so, sports such as men's ice hockey and women's basketball were saved. According to 21st Maccabiah CEO Roy Hessing, by allowing the previously unheard-of mixed teams, between 300-400 more athletes participated in the Games last July.

In total, the Maccabiah had 10,250, of which 8,000 were athletes, representing sixty-four countries.

As far as "bigger is better" and exposing Jewish athletes to their heritage and Israel, Mission accomplished!



From July 6th through the 12th, 2022 over 1200 athletes, coaches, managers, educators, and medical team members embarked on the experience of a lifetime, Maccabi USA's signature program, Israel Connect (IC). Starting as a 2-day domestic training camp in 1985, IC has become one of the jewels in the crown of Maccabi USA programming. Our six-day immersive cultural, educational, and athletic experience is unique to Maccabi USA and unlike any other programming offered in Israel. In the 37 years that IC has evolved, we have learned to balance the competitive needs of our athletes with the importance of experiencing Israel in an authentic and impactful way. Incorporating 5 team practice sessions, daily themed educational content, first-person testimony form Holocaust survivors, key historic and cultural sites in Israel, along with the Phyllis Magerman Bar/Bat Mitzvah Ceremony, IC was lifechanging and prepared our delegation members to fully engage in the Maccabiah experience and achieve Maccabi USA's goal of connecting

There were many innovations in the 21st Maccabiah IC including daily themes, two-a-day practices, specially selected and trained Maccabi Education Fellows, and, most importantly, the inclusion of Lev L'Lev (Heart to Heart) the largest ever delegation-wide day of service.

American Jews to the land and people of Israel, building Jewish identity,

and building Jewish pride through sports.

We are grateful to our many sponsors and partners for supporting and developing this amazing program including the JNF Boruchin Foundation, the Seed the Dream Foundation, the Paul Singer Foundation, the Jewish Education Project/ RootOne, the iCenter, Routes Travel, and Maccabi World Union/Kfar Maccabiah.

Without her tireless efforts IC could not have become the ground-breaking experiential Israel education program that has become a model for us and other organizations moving forward.











Daily highlights and themes of the experience included:

WEDNESDAY, JULY 6, 2022 (7 TAMMUZ 5782)

WELCOME TO ISRAEL

Met the delegation and enjoyed the Israeli music and snacks as you settled into your accommodation center.







THURSDAY, JULY 7, 2022 (8 TAMMUZ 5782)

ISRAEL AS OUR ANCESTRAL HOME: OUR RELATIONSHIPS WITH THE LANDSCAPES AND PEOPLE OF ISRAEL

By tracing the paths of our ancient ancestors, we deepened our relationship with the land and people of Israel. We discussed what it means for Israel to be the 'Promised Land,' began to understand the ancient conflicts in the early establishment of the Jewish homeland and met some of the diverse people who live here and our Israeli peers.

The day included a morning practice and a visit to an ancient historic site, a falafel lunch in a national park, a hike to experience the natural landscape of our homeland, and dinner in a Druze village.









FRIDAY, JULY 8, 2022 (9 TAMMUZ 5782)

ISRAEL AS A MODERN LAND: TEL AVIV

After a morning training session, we enjoyed a walking tour of the modern city of Tel Aviv (established in 1909) which played an important part in the growth and development of the State of Israel. From the roots of Zionism, the declaration of the State at Independence Hall, to the center of the "Start-up Nation, Tel Aviv defines modernity through a Jewish lens. With stops at the thriving artists market at Nachlat Binyamin and the lunch in the bustling Shuk HaCarmel as Israelis prepared for the coming shabbat, the delegation experienced the blend of Jewish culture and Jewish ritual unique to Tel Aviv. Our day concluded with a beautiful Maccabi USA Shabbat Experience including a community Kabbalat Shabbat and special Shabbat Dinner in our accommodation centers.







SHABBAT, JULY 9, 2022 (10 TAMMUZ 5782)

SHABBAT IN THE HOLY LAND: ISRAEL AS A LAND OF RITUAL

We explored the meaning of Shabbat and the notion of making Shabbat meaningful along with the role of ritual in Israel and at home. Delegation members had an opportunity to experience Shabbat through a religious lens at their accommodation centers or a more secular one, visiting Neve Midbar & Kalia Beachat the Dead Sea and the historic fortress of Masada. The day concluded with a special Havdalah service marking the end of Shabbat and a special community dinner.













SUNDAY, JULY 10, 2022 (11 TAMMUZ 5782)

MEET THE PEOPLE OF ISRAEL: LEV L'LEV (HEART TO HEART) - A DAY OF SERVICE

The day included two-a-day training (morning and afternoon). In the largest single-day of service by a visiting foreign delegation ever we fanned out across the country to have a meaningful hands-on volunteer experience, met, and interacted with a variety of the different peoples who are part of the modern state of Israel, heard their stories to better understand how they connect to the land. Our delegation spent time at an amazing variety of sites including: Beit Halochem, Jerusalem; Emunah Achuzat Sara, Bnei Barak; Shalva, Jerusalem; Ashdod Hospital, Ashdod; Various Nursing Homes: Rosh Hayin, Ramat Gan, Mashad Herzelia, Neot Yhud; Yad Lakashish Center, Neve Sharet; Israel Sports Center for the Disabled, Ramat Gan; Center for Therapeutic Riding, Tel Mond; Israel Tennis Center, Yoqnam; Lakashish Center, Ramat Aviv; Kibbutzim at Sde Moshe, Bnei Reem, Zavdiel, Nir Banim; the Israeli Volleyball Association, Wingate; and the Yoseftal Center, Kfar Saba.

Following dinner, the delegation heard first-person testimony from a Survivor of the Holocaust: "When you listen to a witness, you become a witness."





MONDAY, JULY 11, 2022 12 TAMMUZ 5782

ISRAEL AS AN ANCIENT AND MODERN JEWISH HOME: THE ROLE AND PLACE OF MEMORY

Our last full day included a deep and meaningful day in our capital city, Jerusalem. We explored a tragic part of our story through our visit to Yad Vashem. We reflected on the role that memory plays in Judaism and how that translates to our lives back home. We walked the Jewish Quarter of the Old City and had a chance to leave a note and pray at the Kotel. Finally, our entire delegation came together for a unique and special Bar/Bat Mitzvah Ceremony at Hebrew University on Mount Scopus where individuals had an opportunity to become Bar/Bat Mitzvah for the first time, for the first time in Israel, or simply to reaffirm the covenant. We celebrated the simcah after at Maccabim, the historic home of our movement's ancient namesake, the Maccabees.







TUESDAY, JULY 12, 2022 13 TAMMUZ 5782

CELEBRATE THE MACCABI USA DELEGATION

After a final morning practice, all of our Maccabi USA Delegation to 21st Maccabiah gathered at K'far Maccabiah (The Maccabi Village). Our flag bearer Stuart Weitzman was named, we remembered those in our Maccabi community lost since the previous Maccabiah and celebrated together as one team before heading to our individual accommodation centers in anticipation of the start of competition.
