



ARCHERY REGULATIONS

Last Update: 31.07.2024

1. Organization

- a. The Sports Department of the 22nd Maccabiah will be responsible for the Archery competitions of the 22nd Maccabiah.
- b. The Archery competitions will be conducted according to the World Archery Rules and Regulations.
- c. Participation in the competition is open to any athlete who is in possession of a Participant Card, issued by the Organizing Committee of the 22nd Maccabiah and registered for the Archery competitions.
- d. Each participating country may enter up to ten (10) competitors for each of the individual events in each category.
- e. For the team events, each participating country may enter one team of 4 competitors (3 + 1 reserve).
- f. For the males' competition, a minimum of four (4) entries by different participating countries is required in each category.
- g. For the females' competition, a minimum of three (3) entries by different participating countries is required in each category.

2. Venues and Times

The Sport Department of the 22nd Maccabiah will determine the venues and times of the Archery competitions and teams will be notified accordingly.

3. System of Competition

- a. Male: Individual competition will be held in Recurve, Compound and Barebow divisions, at the following ranges: Recurve at 18m and 70m, Compound at 18m and 50m, and Barebow at 18m and 50m.
- b. Female: Individual competition will be held in Recurve, Compound and Barebow divisions, at the following ranges: Recurve at 18m and 70m, Compound at 18m and 50m and Barebow at 18m and 50m.
- c. Mixed Team Event: will be held in the Recurve, Compound and Barebow divisions, with a minimum of three (3) entries from the participating countries.

4. Judging and Event Management

The Sport Department will work closely with the Israeli Archery Association, which will be responsible for the professional aspect of the competitions. The Sport Department will select a Judges' Committee and will appoint a Director of Shooting and a Technical Delegate to oversee the technical aspects of the competitions. All other decisions will be made with the guidance of and in coordination with the Organizing Committee of the 22nd Maccabiah and the Sports Department.



5. General

- a. These regulations are but one part of the complete 22nd Maccabiah Regulations and must be read along with the instructions found in the Maccabiah Basic Regulations.
- b. In the event of a discrepancy between the regulations written here and those appearing in the Maccabiah Basic Regulations, the regulations written here will prevail, apply and be binding.
