

## RHYTHMIC GYMNASTICS REGULATIONS

Last Update: 28.08.2024

## 1. Organization

- a. The Gymnastics Committee of the 22<sup>nd</sup> Maccabiah will be responsible for the Rhythmic Gymnastics competitions of the 22<sup>nd</sup> Maccabiah, subject to the approval of the Sport Department.
- b. The competition will be organized under the following FIG rules, as valid in the year of the Competition:
  - Code of Ethics
  - Code of Conduct
  - Technical Regulations
  - Code of Points, relevant Newsletters, and Helpdesk
  - General Judges' Rules
  - Specific Judges' Rules for Artistic Gymnastics
  - FIG Framework for Safeguarding Athletes and other Participants from Harassment and abuse in Sport during Events.
- c. Participation in the competition is open to any athlete who is in possession of a Participant Card, issued by the Organizing Committee of the 22<sup>nd</sup> Maccabiah, and is registered for the Rhythmic Gymnastics competitions.
- d. Each country may enter up to four (4) competitors for the individual open competitions born 2009 and older and up to four (4) competitors for the individual juniors (2010-2011) competitions.

#### Remark:

No gymnast will be allowed to register for the Competition without being accompanied by a coach.

The Host Federation shall not, under any circumstance, provide coaching services and /or allow the gymnasts participation in the competition without a coach.

## 2. Venues and times

- a. The Gymnastics Committee of the 22nd Maccabiah will determine the venues and times of the Rhythmic Gymnastics competitions and teams will be notified accordingly.
- b. The Gymnastics Committee is authorized to change the venues and times of the competitions. These decisions will be final.
- c. The competitions will be held in a hall, according to the rules of the International Gymnastics Federation.



## 3. General Program of the competition

The all-round competition will include four exercises :(Open /junior)

 (1) Exercise with HOOP
 1:15-1:30

 (2) Exercise with BALL
 1:15-1:30

 (3) Exercise with CLUBS
 1:15-1:30

 (4) Exercise with RIBBON
 1:15-1:30

## 4. System of competition

The RG Competition shall consist of:

#### Junior All Around Competition

The Gymnasts shall take part in an All-Around Competition during which every gymnasts shall present all 4 apparatus (Hoop, Ball, Clubs, Ribbon).

### Open (Senior) All Around Competition

The Gymnasts shall take part in an All-Around Competition during which every gymnasts shall present all 4 apparatus (Hoop, Ball, Clubs, Ribbon).

The results of aforementioned AA Competition shall determine:

- 1. The winners of the AA Title.
- 2. The winners of the individual apparatus (there will be no separate apparatus finals).

## 5. Drawing of lots

The gymnasts' drawing of lots of date shall be published at a later date and in accordance with the Maccabiah registration process.

# 6. Classification

- a. General individual classification will be decided upon according to the results obtained by each gymnast on all the apparatus together, in competition no. 1.
- b. Individual classification on each apparatus will be decided upon according to the results of the Final.

## 7. Music

According to FIG rules.







## 8. Judges

- a. Each country is allowed to register up to 2 eligible judges holding an FIG judge's category.
- b. The judges panel will be composed under FIG regulations and the Host Federation shall complete the judges panel with its local judges as required.
- c. The judging of the competition will be according to the regulations of the FIG and the current code of points.

## 9. General

- a. These regulations are but one part of the complete 22<sup>nd</sup> Maccabiah Regulations and must be read along with the instructions found in "Basic Regulations and Disciplinary Procedures".
- b. In the event of a discrepancy between the regulations written here and those appearing in the "Basic Regulations", the regulations written here will apply and be binding.
- c. A detailed work plan with all relevant competition information shell be published prior to the participants arrival.
- d. The Organizing Committee, upon approval from the sport department, is Authorize to make changes in the competition format if necessary, according to the total number of participants and NF.
