LOU MOYERMAN

Louis “Lou” Moyerman has spent over four decades advancing Jewish identity and athletic excellence through Maccabi USA, Maccabi World Union, and judo. A Gold Medalist and Captain of the 1981 U.S. Maccabiah Judo Team, he has served as coach, the USA Team Manager, and general chair across 16 international Maccabi competitions. Moyerman has held roles as Judo Chair, Sports Chair, General Chairman of the U.S. Maccabiah Delegation, and Vice President of Maccabi USA, and now serves as Vice President of Maccabi World Union and International Chairman of the Junior Maccabiah. He was also an Olympic staff member for the 2000 Olympic judo team. Honored as a Legend of the Maccabiah, he continues to inspire athletes and volunteers worldwide.



Outside Maccabi, Moyerman worked in the School District of Philadelphia for 35 years as a teacher, coach, and athletic director. He led Liberty Bell Judo for four decades, developing national and international champions. A Temple University graduate with a Master’s in Health Education, he has also contributed to physical education and community self-defense programs. Lou Moyerman’s lifelong dedication to sport, education, and service has made him a respected mentor and a pillar of the global Jewish athletic community.
